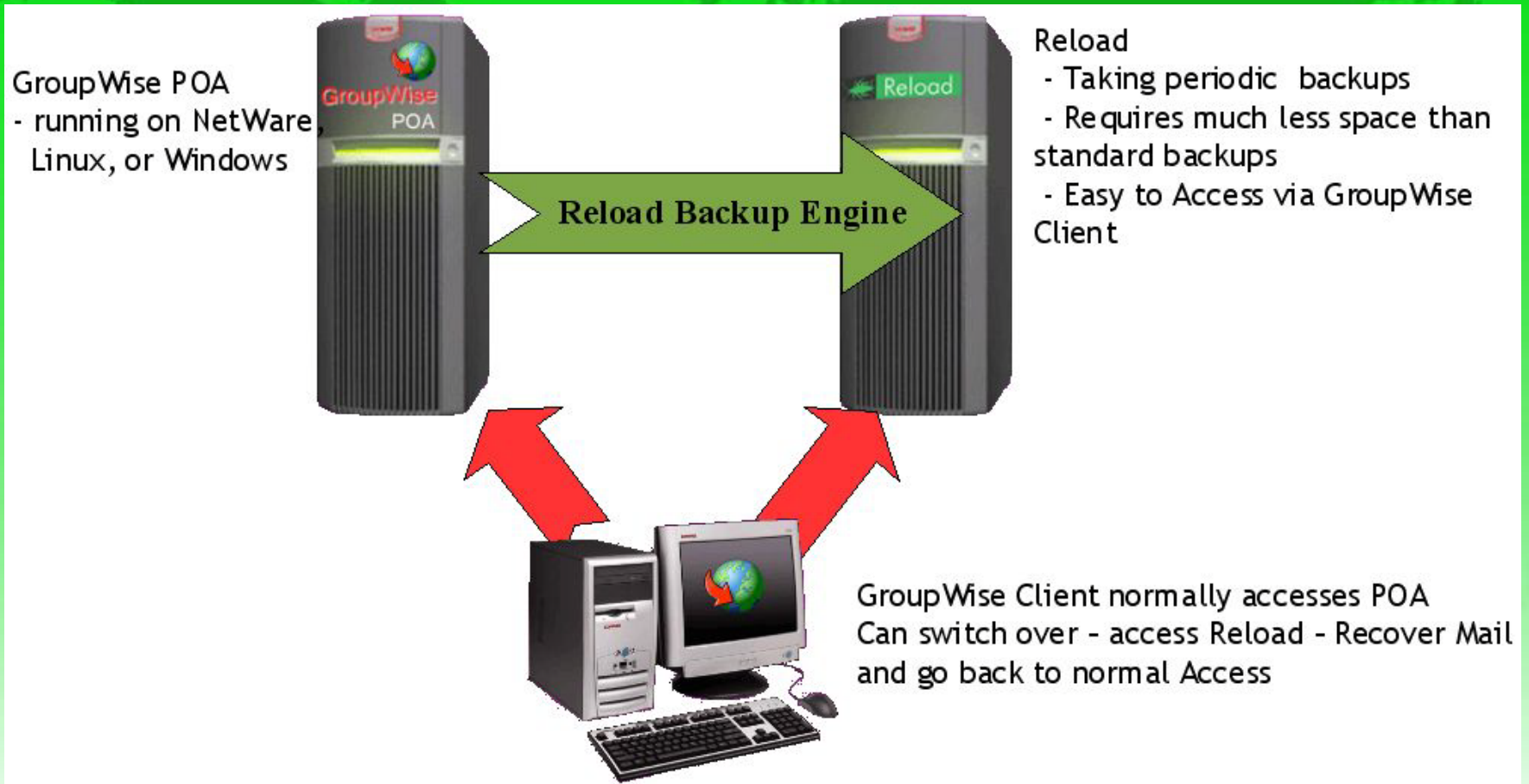

Reload

- Hot Backup and Disaster Recovery
- Instant access to backed up data
- Works with GW on any platform
- Restore email, address books etc
- Maintains GW format & security
- One click Disaster Recovery Mode
- Super fast backups
- No software installed on GW system

How it works



Superior Hot Backup

- GroupWise SmartPurge Integration
- All items are backed up
- Nothing can be purged from Reload
- Backup Speeds are very fast
- Only 12% of the post office is replicated and stored each day
- Every Reload backup is the equivalent to a full backup of the post office.
- On disk, it just looks like a GroupWise post office
- Reload backups are immediately usable for data restore or disaster recovery

Quickly Restore Data

- Native GroupWise client access to a backup in 1 minute
- Restore any message item
- Restore address books
- No software to install for clients
- Platform independent solution
- Be up and running on the Reload server in 2 minutes
- No backup sets to combine, no decisions to make, just push the “Failover” button, that’s it!
- Disaster Recovery for GroupWise post offices and domains

Other Notable Features

- Intra-day backups
 - Still only 12% a day stored on disk
 - Chicago law firm performing backups every two hours from 6:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.
- Concurrent Backups
 - Small Backup Windows
- Worry Free
 - A consolidated Daily Status Report e-mail
 - Warning and Error Thresholds for proactive e-mail notification
 - At-a-glance monitoring

Geeky Stuff

- Reload Mobile
 - Administration on the road
 - Call custom commands at certain job states
 - So you have some cool idea, go ahead
 - Add custom links to the Web Interface
 - Lots of default parameters that can be changed and fine-tuned

Reload 3.1

- Compatible with GroupWise 8.0.1 and SLES11
- Increased Reload's Ease of Use (UI layout, screen order, increased help documentation)
- Added support for DNS based connectivity for backups of post offices and domains
- Significantly enhanced the Migration features of Reload (very useful for customers migrating to Linux)
- Added intelligent job queuing to favor getting backup jobs done first before performing maintenance type jobs
- Strengthened Reload's ability to detect and recover from failed backup attempts
- The ability to add more custom buttons to the Reload Web Administration interface
- A web-based API that allows commands to be executed on the Reload server
