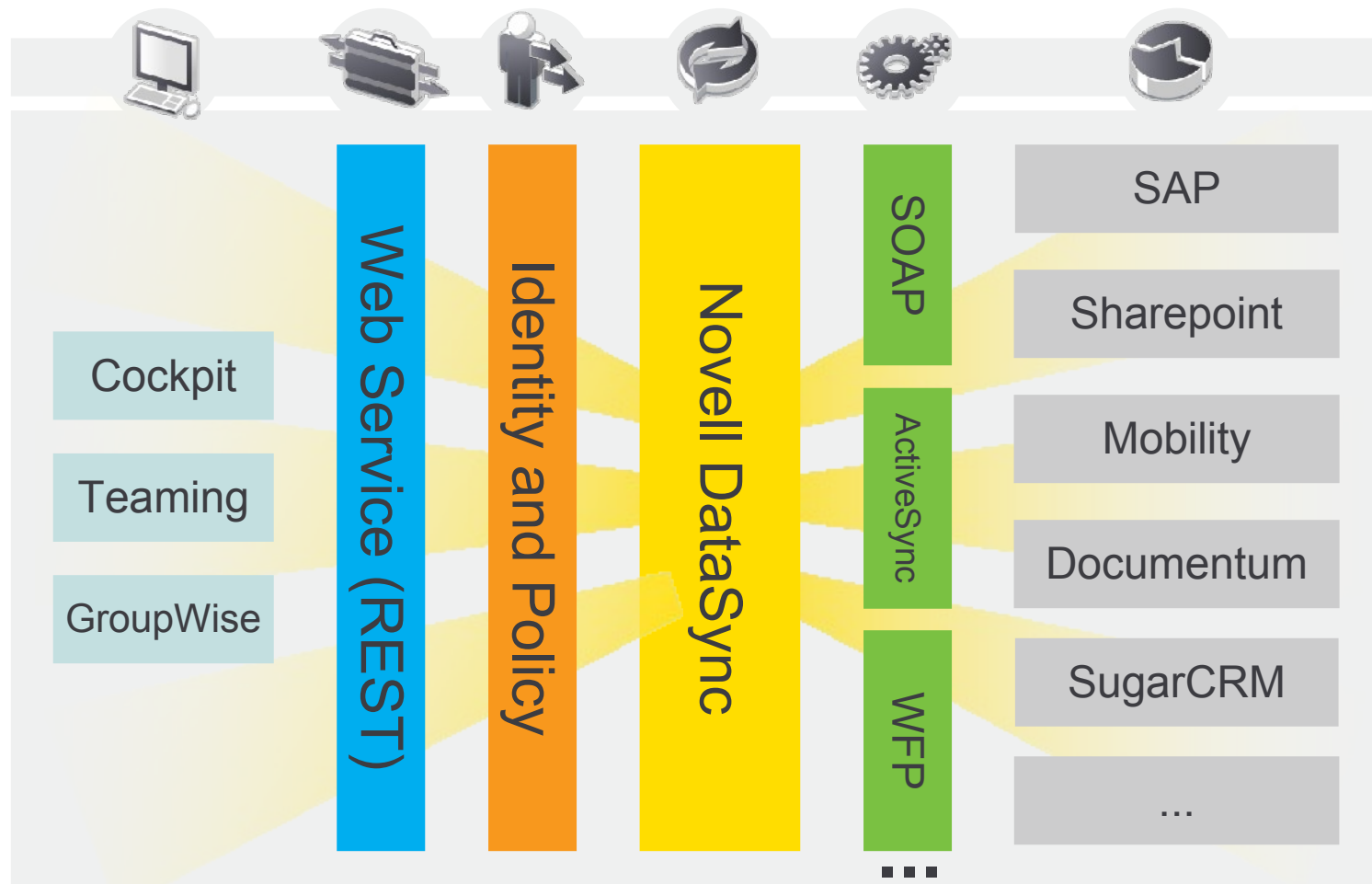
DataSync Overview
